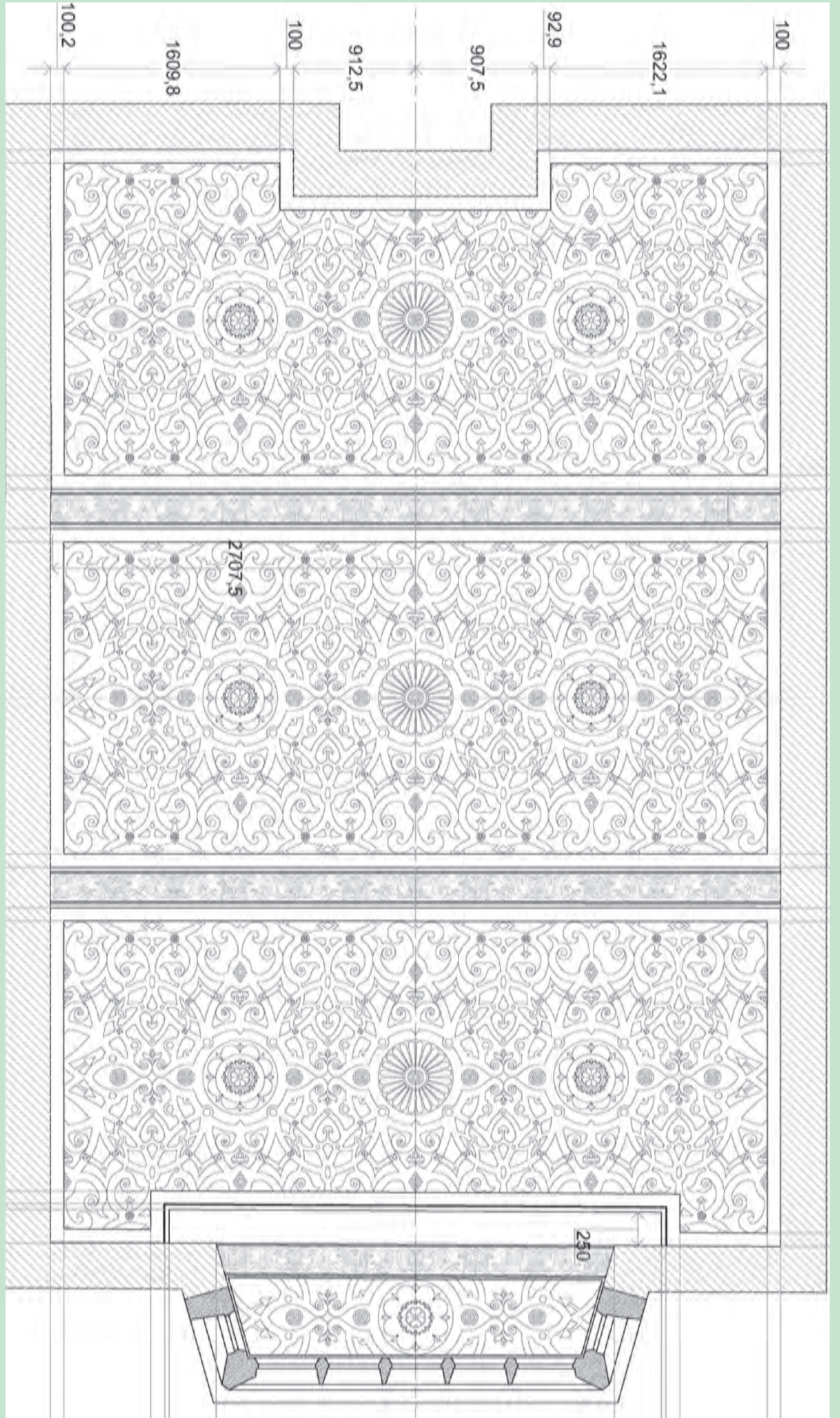
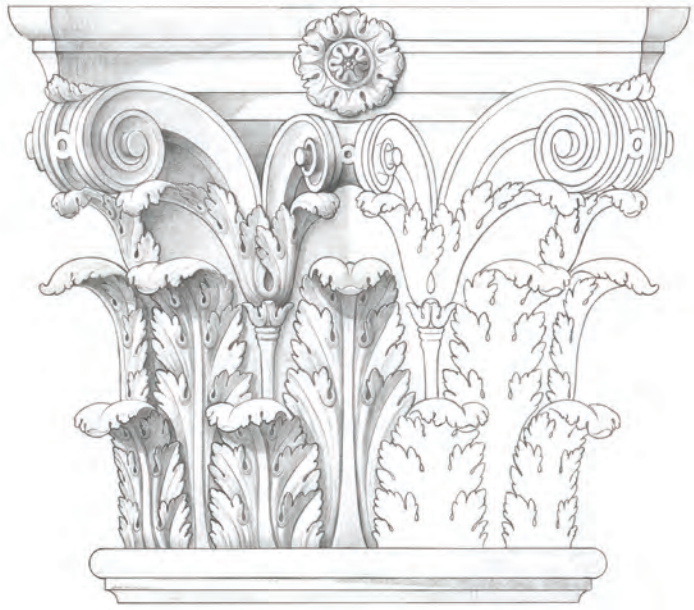


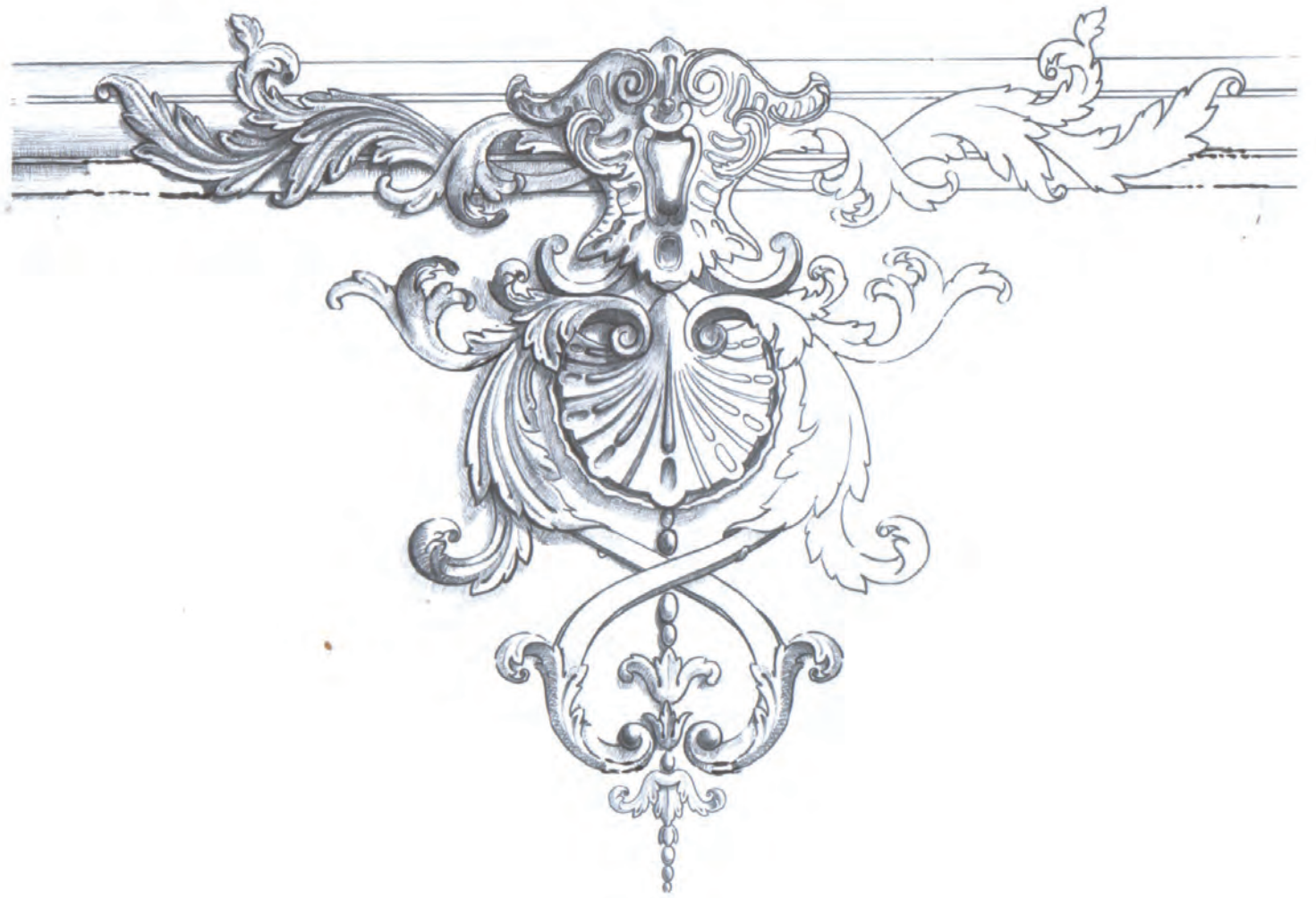
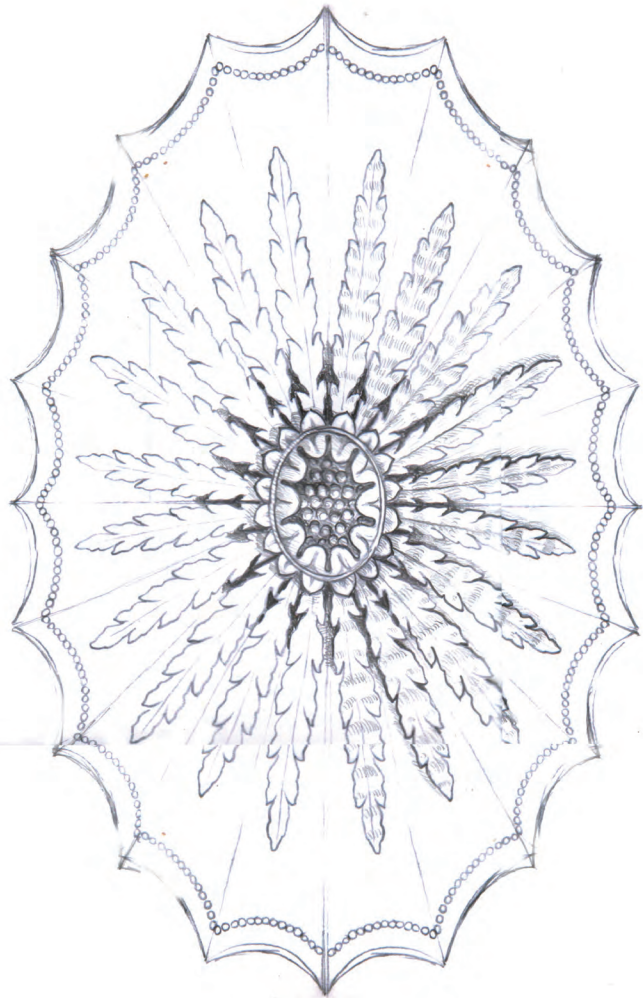


DESIGN

Hayles and Howe specialise in the design, manufacture and install of bespoke and beautiful ornamental fibrous plaster ceilings.

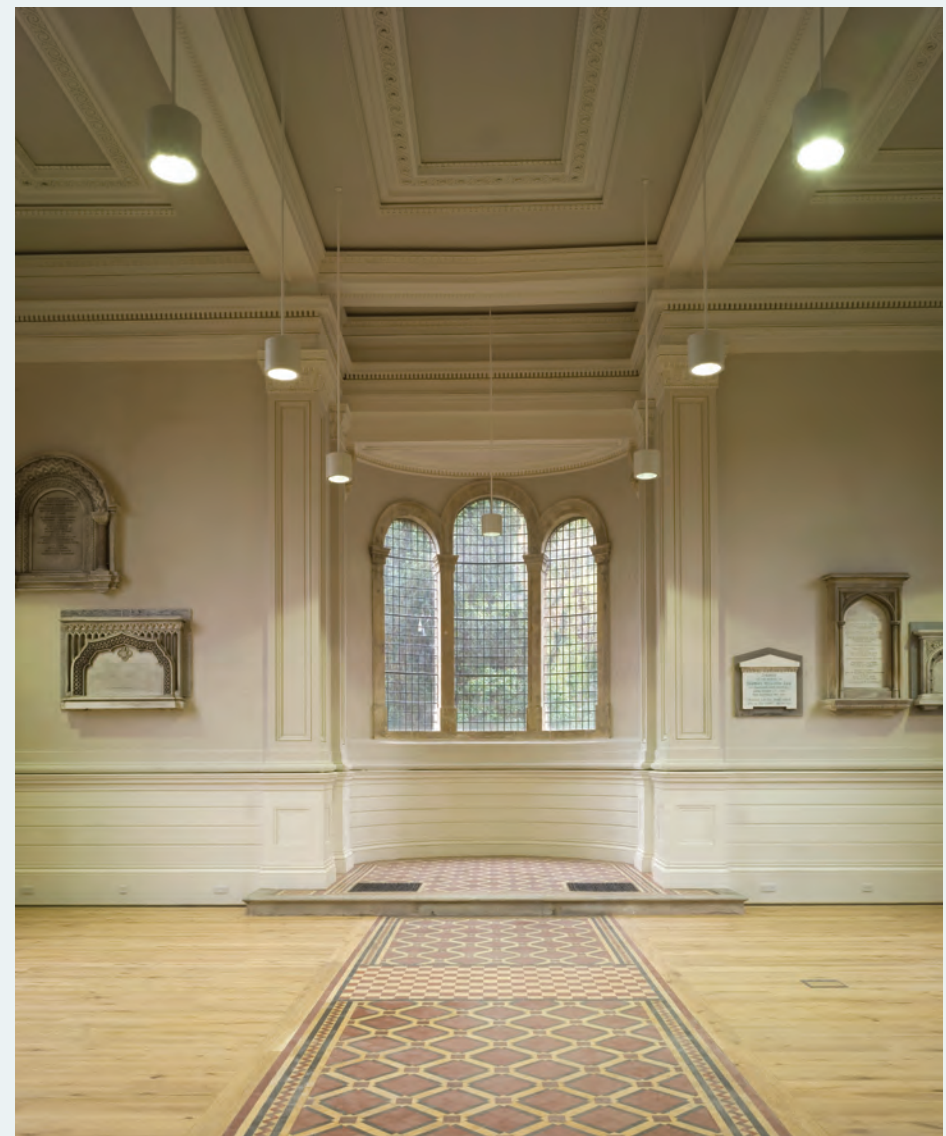


SPECIALIST *Plasterwork* Restoration and Conservation

Bespoke

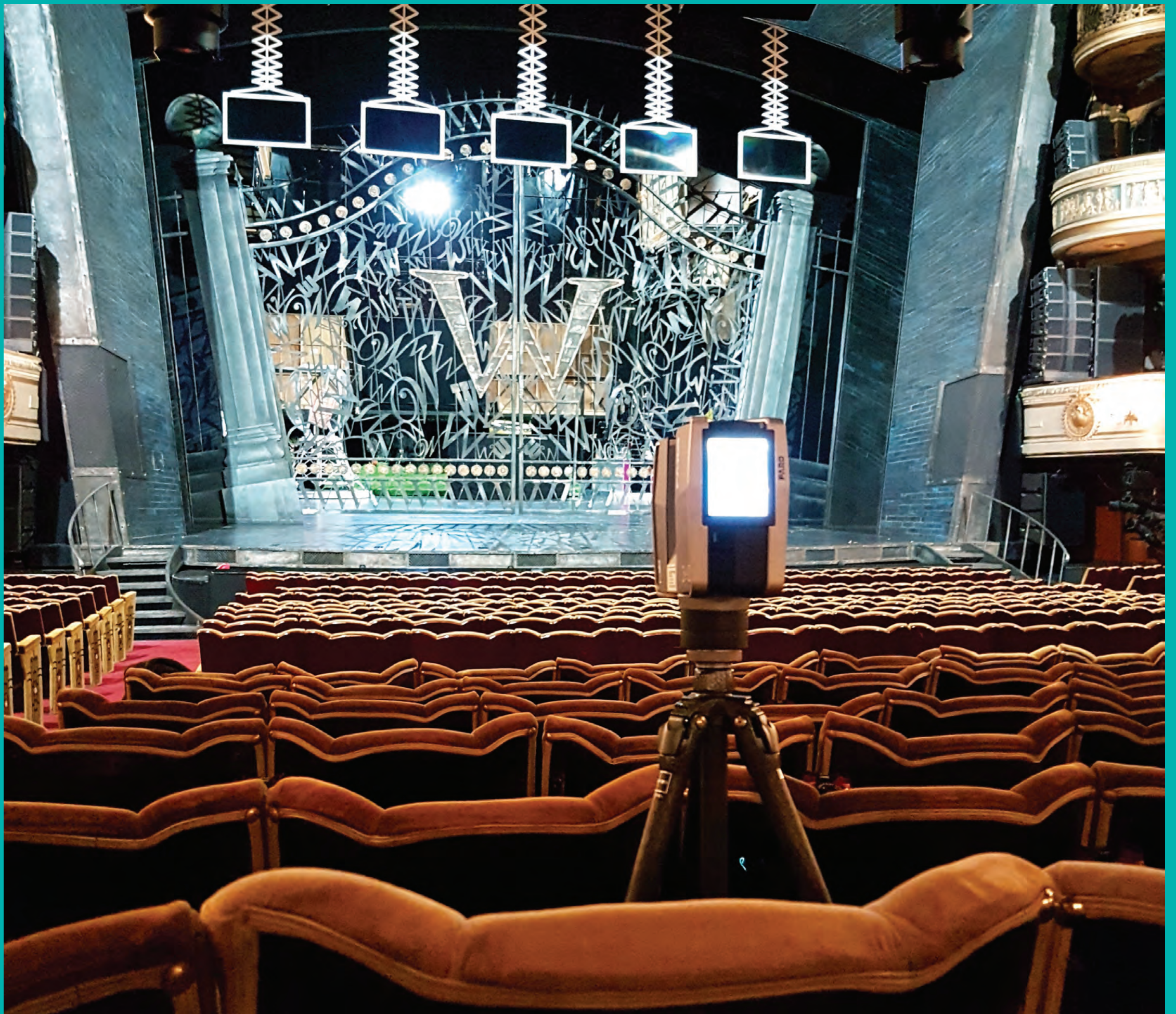

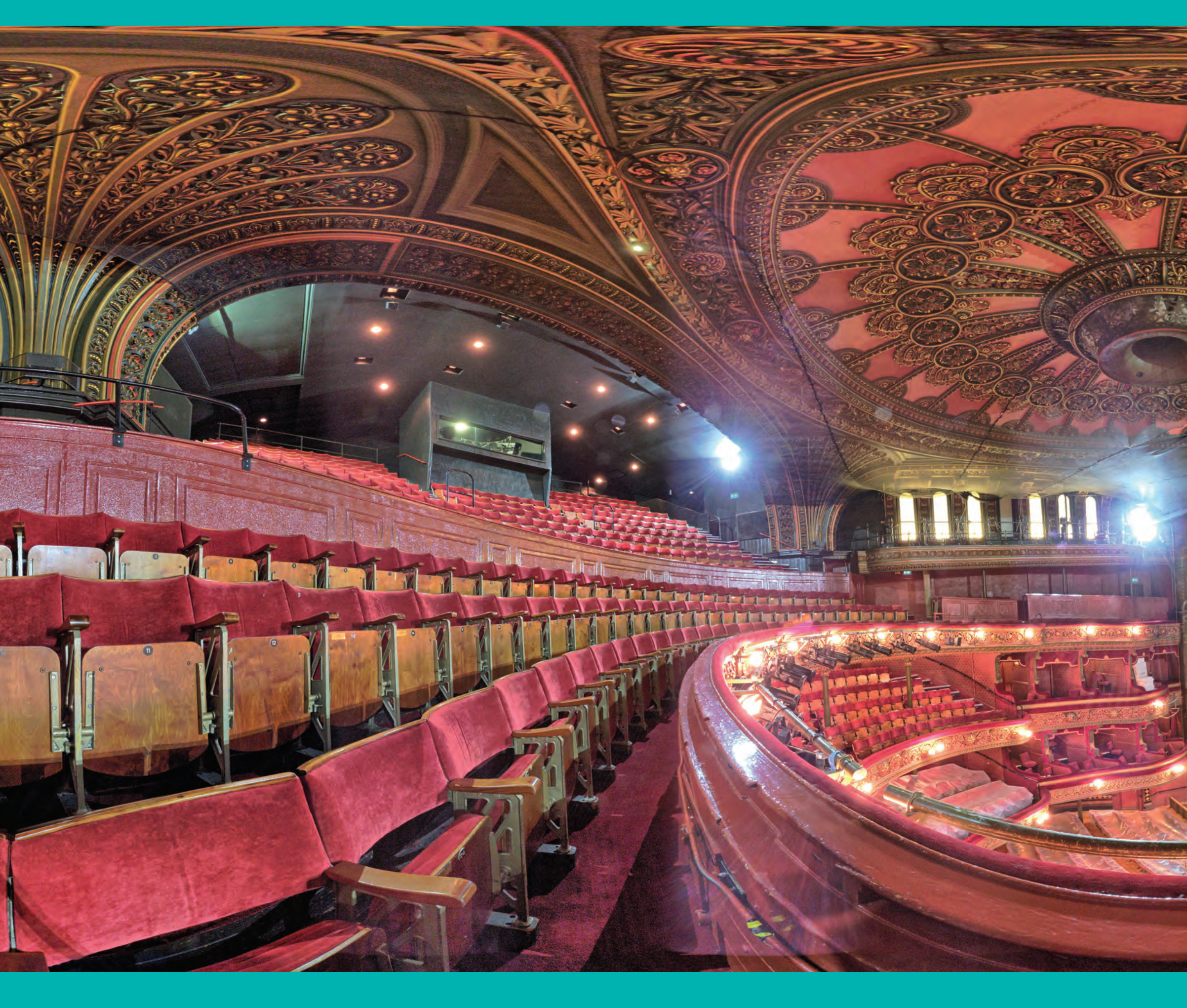


3D Laser SCANNING

Hayles and Howe have recently acquired a 3D laser scanner. This incredible piece of technology enables you to capture any environment in any condition with millimetre accuracy.

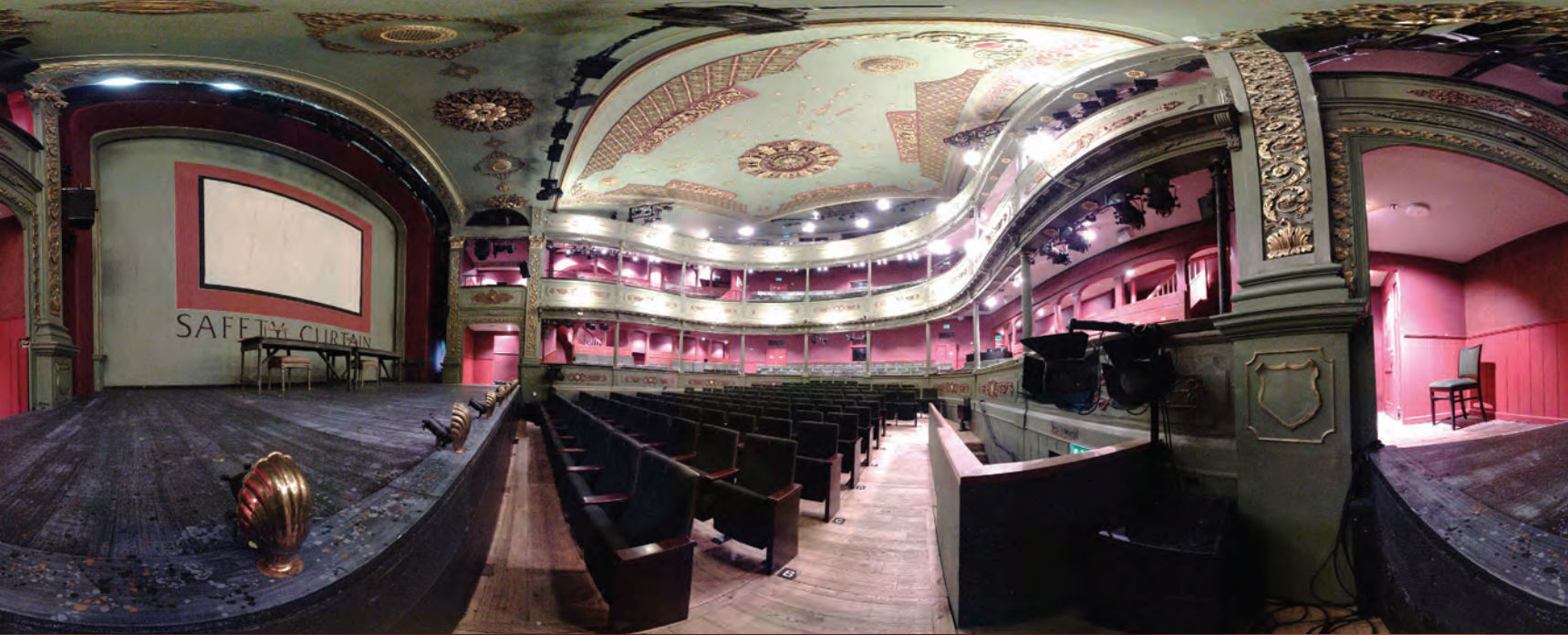
The scanner is operated by our skilled designer and provides cost efficient working and ease of use on site.

The point cloud data captured by the scan can be used to create fly through videos, Webshare interactive files and reflective ceiling plans either in captured light or hand traced drawings.

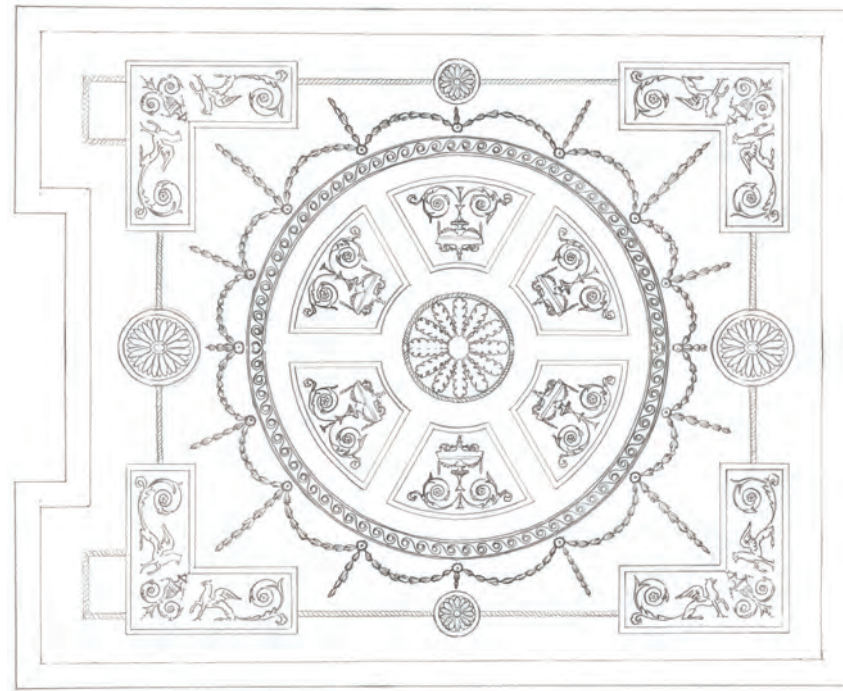
